Dear Friend,

This year we are marking the 65<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the murder of Korczak, the teachers and the children of the orphanage. Two main events will mark the day. In Israel, two ceremonies took place on August 6, one in the Polish Jewry Forest, where there is a monument to their memory, and where young people flew kites containing wishes – and at Yad Vashem, where the official ceremony, which was attended by hundreds of people, took place.

The second event will take place in Treblinka on September 15, 2007.

We, the members of the International Korczak Association, will meet, as we do every year, in order to together promote Korczak's educational, humanistic and pluralistic legacy throughout the world.

The meeting will take place in Mannheim, Germany on Saturday Oct. 27, 2007, between 9:45 and 13:00, during the festivities in celebration of the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Janusz Korczak Association in Germany (attached please find an invitation, registration information and the program).
